EYFS/Phase 1 Reception-Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Greetings in different languages during morning routine
<p>French is studied at John Chilton School from year 4-year 11. The units of study take into account the National Curriculum requirements and the needs of the pupils. At John Chilton School, we use different approaches such as exploration, singing, interactive stories and games to develop introductory vocabulary and phrases. The focus is listening, speaking and communication. More able pupils also have opportunities to expand on their writing skills.</p>
