



INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **John Chilton School**
2. The school is a **Community Special School**.
3. The name of the Governing Board is "The Governing Board of **John Chilton School**."
4. The Governing Board shall consist of ¹:
 - a) Three Parent Governors
 - b) One LA Governor (if the LA is unable to appoint a representative Governor, the school may consider an additional Co-opted Governor)
 - c) One Staff Governor (either a teacher Governor or a non-teacher Governor – see f below)
 - d) One Headteacher
 - e) Five Co-opted Governors.

One of these shall be an additional Staff Governor. If the present Governor in 4c above is a Teacher Governor then a Non-Teacher Governor shall be co-opted. If the present Governor is a Non-Teacher Governor then a Teacher Governor shall be co-opted. The additional Staff Governor shall be chosen by election.

Three of these shall be co-opted from the wider community taking into account the Governing Board's needs at a time.

5. Total number of Governors **11**
6. The term of office of parent, staff, LA and Co-Opted Governors is for **four** years.
7. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1/1/2013
8. This instrument was made by order of The Council of the London Borough of Ealing on 20th December 2012
9. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the Governing Board
