

Post 16 Pathways / Transition at John Chilton School

Phase 4 Blue and Violet

- Pupils complete JCS certificate in 'Personal Progress'.
- Pupils access 'In house' simulated work experiences and curriculum visits exploring the world of work.
- Most Blue Group pupils continue post 16 education into 6th form. Some Violet group pupils stay at JCS 6th form, while some transition into college



Phase 4 Blue and Violet

- Pupils attend JCS 6th form.
- They develop life skills and complete the JCS certificate in 'Preparation for Adulthood.'
- Pupils run the school café, gain work experience gardening in our allotment as well as animal care sessions.
- Pupils gain work experiences within the community through various on-going projects.
- Pupils and families visit local mainstream and specialist college provisions and are supported with post 19 decision making.



 Pupils have had successful placements at local specialist college provision, including:

Oaklands College (St. Albans)
Great Oaks College (Hounslow)
Orchard Hill College (Hillingdon)
Harrow College
Green Corridor – Vocational training
college

Phase 4 Purple

- Pupils complete formal examinations from year 9 working on Entry Level 1 – 3 qualifications in Maths and English and ICT.
- Pupils participate in regular workshops and work experiences with external agencies and gain experiences of visiting local colleges and specialist provision within mainstream colleges.
- Pupils are made aware of supported apprenticeships and college courses.



Phase 4 Purple

- Pupils most likely to attend local mainstream college provisions with inclusive learning units.
- We work closely with:
 West London College Hammersmith
 West London College Ealing Green
 West London College Southall
 Uxbridge College
 Harrow College
 West Thames College
- Supported internship providers: Project
 Choice, Project Search

Phase 4 Red (Y11)

- Pupils complete formal examinations from year 9 working on Entry Level 1 – 3 up to level 1 qualifications in Maths and English and ICT.
- Pupils participate in workshops and supported work experience placements.
- Pupils attend college and internship fayres to gain information about opportunities for education and employment.
- Monthly consultations with Connexions professionals.
- Pupils most likely to attend inclusive learning in mainstream colleges.



Phase 4 Red (Y11)

- Pupils most likely to attend local mainstream colleges with inclusive learning departments.
- Some pupils graduate to mainstream courses with additional support in place.
- Pupils have had successful placements at:
 West London College, Uxbridge College,
 Harrow College, Capel Manor College, West
 Thames College.
- Pupils have accessed supported internship programmes at NHS and Project Choice
